

Meeting Month	November 2021
BURIAL GROUNDS	Damage to Churchyard wall now repaired, funded by insurance with contribution from neighbour. 10 new “RES” markers ordered for Cemetery, awaiting delivery.
ROADS AND VERGES Street Lights	Generally, verges have recovered well from earlier vehicle damage. Outage of several street lights on 13/10 - lights checked by supplier, no fault found. Most likely cause was a fault in HV supply south of Daventry a few hours earlier. Monitor.
TREES AND GREENS	Crown reduction completed on horse chestnut on corner of The Glebe with Chapel Lane and Main Street, and Remembrance decorations put in place by the WI Knitwits. Crown lift to trees on the Green complete. Drain on small Green in Stoneway blocked and overflowed again in heavy rain conditions. Anglian Water have cleared it, but layout of pipe-line means it is likely to recur unless re-laid.
PARISH WORKS	Repair to crossing on Knightley Way between Honey Lane and the woods now complete, thanks to donor of the hard-core and Type 1 MOT, to farmer for transporting it to site and helping to lay it, and to volunteers.
FOOTPATHS	Footpath EB15 alongside brook behind Park Close passable again following clearance work by Parish Council., but concern raised about a short section which slopes down to the brook. Reported via Fix My Street, together with the fact that WNC Highways did not clear the vegetation as promised.
PLAYING FIELD AND ALLOTMENTS	Nothing to report.
VILLAGE HALL AND PLAY AREA	Very successful Race Night raised over £900 for Village Hall funds. Weekly play area checks carried out, no faults found.
DEFIBRILLATOR	Weekly checks carried out, no faults found. Pads expire 11/21 and will be replaced. Awaiting completion of electrical work at Village Hall to accommodate a heated cabinet.
POLICE LIAISON	Nothing to report.
PLANNING	Amendment submitted to application for change of use of The Windmill Inn, deadline for comments 22/11. Application submitted for alterations at Byron House in Chapel Lane – deadline for comments 23/11.
