

Meeting Month	March 2022
BURIAL GROUNDS	Further clearance work was done at the Churchyard and the Cemetery by the working party on 6 March. SC will arrange another session with James Burton, date TBD.
ROADS AND VERGES	Openreach have informed a resident of The Glebe that they plan to install FTTP by July, using trenching.
TREES AND GREENS	Further damage has been caused to The Green in front of Greystones by a vehicle reversing on the soft ground. As agreed, SC and PJ will erect wooden posts as soon as possible. A site for a Jubilee Tree has been identified on The Green. Subject to agreement, and permission to remove an existing tree which is suffering from terminal blight, the new tree will be planted in November. It has been suggested that a child be chosen at the Jubilee celebrations to assist with the planting and that a time capsule be planted nearby.
PARISH WORKS	The working party on 6 March attracted around 13 volunteers. It is hoped to build on the interest generated and encourage more members of the public to participate in regular working parties.
FOOTPATHS	The owner of the land alongside Footpath EB15 is seeking guidance from WNC's Flood Risk Management section about the right way to clear overgrown vegetation from the brook.
PLAYING FIELD AND ALLOTMENTS	Nothing to report.
VILLAGE HALL AND PLAY AREA	Weekly play area equipment checks carried out, no faults found.
DEFIBRILLATOR	Delivery of the replacement (green) heated defibrillator cabinet is still awaited.
POLICE LIAISON	Nothing to report.
PLANNING	Three new planning applications will be discussed at the Parish Council meeting on 14 March. No response yet received from WNC to the Parish Council's application to nominate the Windmill Inn as an Asset of Community Value (ACV).
WEBSITE	Invoices received for annual website hosting and support, total £195.98.

OTHER – QUEEN'S JUBILEE	A meeting took place on 8 March to discuss a village event to mark the Queen's Jubilee on 5 June.
