

Meeting Month	April 2023
BURIAL GROUNDS	New interment took place in the Cemetery on 20 March. Some damage subsequently noted to turfed areas, most likely from the use of a mini-excavator by the grave-digger. First cut of the Cemetery completed by new contractor.
ROADS AND VERGES	Details received from WNC Highways of a proposal for a 40/50 mph speed limit along Staverton Lane, and the views of the parish council requested before Highways proceed to a public notice.
TREES AND GREENS	First cut of the season made to the Greens and verges. Damage noted to verges on School Lane and Pinfold Green following use of a double-decker bus to collect/deliver children at the School.
PARISH WORKS	Date still to be agreed for the next working party. The young son of a resident would like to litter-pick in the village on a date to be agreed, as part of his Duke of Edinburgh award.
FOOTPATHS	Complaint received about effluent flowing from neighbouring property via a pipe onto the public footpath along Honey Lane. As a first step, the matter will be taken up with the owner of the property
PLAYING FIELD AND ALLOTMENTS	The dog waste bin at the entrance to the Playing Field has been replaced.
VILLAGE HALL AND PLAY AREA	The Village Hall held a very successful wine-tasting evening in March to raise funds. The next event will be Bluebell Teas on Sunday 30 April and Monday 1 May.
DEFIBRILLATORS	Warranty replacement battery for the defibrillator at Village Hall has been received and installed.
POLICE LIAISON	The monthly meeting of the PFCC (Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner) with parish and town council representatives will take place on 18 April.
PLANNING	New planning application received for alterations to Rosewood Cottage on Church Green, to be considered at the parish council meeting on 17 April. WNC Planning enforcement have re-visited White Feather and their report is awaited. Their feedback is also still awaited regarding excavation work on land bordering Catesby Lane.
